

Thomas Hartman Memorial Grant

The **THOMAS HARTMAN MEMORIAL GRANT** program awards a one-year tuition assistance grant to an incoming freshman based on strength of character, Christian values, academic performance, participation in extra and co-curricular activities, and future promise. The friends of Thomas Hartman, in tribute to Tom's many contributions to Bishop McDevitt High School, provide funding for the grant. The grant is for ninth grade tuition in an amount to be designated by the benefactors.

ELIGIBILITY

The THOMAS HARTMAN MEMORIAL GRANT award is available to incoming freshmen who are registered for entrance to Bishop McDevitt High School and who have completed the application process and/or have been nominated by their grade school Principal or extra curricular activity leader.

APPLICATION PROCEDURE

Nominated and/or eligible candidates may apply for the award by completing the application materials available from the Office of Institutional Advancement at Bishop McDevitt High School. Applications are due by March 15th, 2010.

SELECTION PROCEDURE

Each applicant must submit a transcript of his/her seventh and eighth grade academic record, along with at least one letter of recommendation from a coach/moderator, to be sent to: Mr. Chris Seifert, Bishop McDevitt High School, 125 Royal Avenue, Wyncote, PA 19095 – Attention: Thomas Hartman Memorial Grant.
